Dear Fleischmann Modeller,

Following the recent news, the sale of the family Fleischmann Company to Modelleisenbahn Holding has now been completed. The main production Fleischmann factory in Heilsbronn, just outside Nürnberg will be the new centre of operations – “Made in Franconia” being the new watchword, whilst the original administrative headquarters in Nürnberg itself will be closed. Some parts may be produced outside Germany, probably in Rumania. Once the restructuring and concentration in Heilsbronn is completed, then just 225 workers out of 340 will remain – a significant proportion of the company has thus been saved.

Deliveries of the Fleischmann ranges will continue as normal, as will the Fleischmann brand name itself.
