Naturally, we wanted to make a **big noise** about this exciting event in the history of Fleischmann in the UK, and here's something to make a big noise with on your layout!

The latest *digital* "Sound on Board" loco from Fleischmann -

In HO Gauge

The mighty Class 50, 2-10-0 freight loco, with the larger Wagner style of smoke deflectors either side of the smokebox door, in DR livery, with prototypical sound decoder. Double headlights. Epoch III. Each of the functions, whistles, etc. can be called up by using the function keys on any make of digital controller.



"Modern Image" now, and the long-awaited double-deck driving trailer coach in HO gauge has just arrived in the shops.

The illuminated destination indicator on the front shows the terminus as "Augsburg".



The latest generation of Görlitz double-deckers has a completely different cab end shape and the windows are positioned differently to the previous models.

Of course, as one would expect from Fleischmann, the white headlights are illuminated when running forwards and red tail lights appear when it is the last coach in the train. (The suitable train loco would be 4324).



The “Profi-Boss”, hand-held digital controller has arrived. The first starter sets with the new controller just arrived in the UK at the end of July!
