The Three Spires Railex is one of the largest exhibitions west of Bristol. The name reflects the fine cathedral which dominates the city, and incidentally is one of only three cathedrals in Britain to have three spires, the others being Lichfield Cathedral and St Mary's Episcopal Cathedral, Edinburgh.

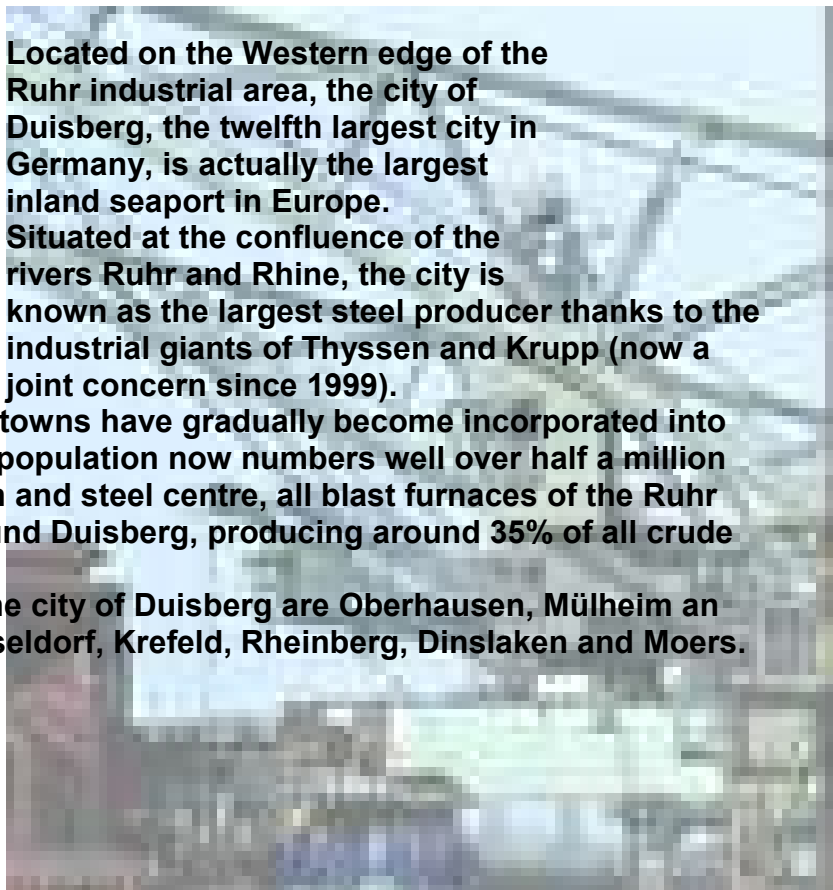

Located on the Western edge of the Ruhr industrial area, the city of Duisburg, the twelfth largest city in Germany, is actually the largest inland seaport in Europe. Situated at the confluence of the rivers Ruhr and Rhine, the city is known as the largest steel producer thanks to the industrial giants of Thyssen and Krupp (now a joint concern since 1999).

As smaller surrounding towns have gradually become incorporated into the city of Duisburg, the population now numbers well over half a million people. As the major iron and steel centre, all blast furnaces of the Ruhr can be found in and around Duisburg, producing around 35% of all crude steel in Germany.

Immediately bordering the city of Duisburg are Oberhausen, Mülheim an der Ruhr, Ratingen, Düsseldorf, Krefeld, Rheinberg, Dinslaken and Moers.



NIAG, the Nieder-Rhein AG [lower Rhine] transport company, provide buses for the Duisberg area. They also specialise in rail freight traffic, with their transfer harbour in Rheinhafen Orsoy. The Rhine Harbour Orsoy depot, with direct connection to road and rail, moves around 3.5million tons of goods each year.

The depot operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

NIAG also operates its own rail fleet of locos and wagons in colourful blue/green and white liveries. Hence the splash of colour in the railway landscape from FLEISCHMANN this year is the new NIAG hopper wagon – available in both HO and N <<piccolo>> gauges:
