Perhaps not quite the sounds of Summer – but certainly “SOUND!” The latest HO loco is the mighty Class 18.5, complete with digital “*Sound on Board*” decoder. The chuff of the steam exhaust, whistles, screeching brakes – all the sounds of the prototype in one exquisitely detailed model.

This loco will work on any digital system, with any digital controller.

And the newly reworked, class 24 loco, complete with decoder socket – the “Prancing Horse”

For N gauge fans – at last the tiny diesel shunter you’ve all been waiting for – the V60 in old DB wine red:

Finally – the tiny workhorse of the DB - the V60 shunter!

Announced last year, but delayed due to the sale / merger negotiations, this exquisite model has at last arrived in the shops!



This little diesel can play an important role on any layout, Either shunting freight wagons around the yard, or moving passenger coaches in and out of the platforms to make up the train prior to departure.

The headlights change *automatically* according to the direction of travel – white forwards and red backwards!

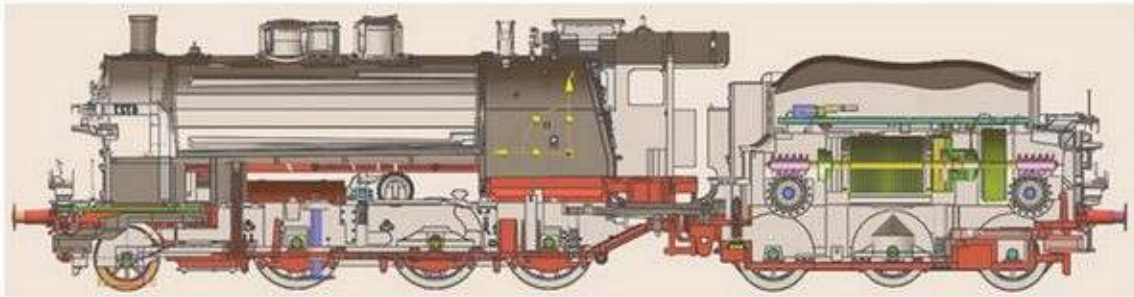
